Dear Map Academy Community,

It is our sincere hope that this letter finds you healthy and well during this strange and unprecedented time. As you know, Governor Baker has extended the current closure through the remainder of the school year. We speak for the entire Map Academy staff when we say that although we know that this was the right decision, we very much wish we could open our doors and go back to full onsite operations. We miss our students and look forward to having everyone back as soon as it is deemed safe. In the meantime, we are writing to provide some updates and ensure you are aware of all of the ways students can access support remotely.

- If you haven't already, we urge you to check the <u>Virtual Student Center</u> (https://themapacademy.org/virtual-student-center) on the Map Academy homepage to see how students can continue to make progress during the closure. It's important to note that Map Academy students continue to control their own academic pace. We're proud to say that many students have been pushing forward and earning credits, and we encourage students who have been stalled to reach out for support in making a plan to jumpstart their progress. Staff are accessible and ready to provide all necessary supports students need to reach their goals.
- To facilitate communication and streamline outreach efforts, each student has been assigned a Remote Learning Case Manager who is responsible for daily academic case management, including check ins and coordination with other staff to ensure academic supports are working smoothly in all content areas. Each Case Manager is also able to provide Special Education supports as needed. You will find a note from your Case Manager enclosed with this letter. - As many of you know, the lower level of the Map Academy building has always been slated for renovation over the course of this spring and summer so that we can begin operating on both floors of the building beginning in Fall 2020. We are happy to report that the construction permit was approved prior to the closure and construction is proceeding with all appropriate public health precautions. We are excited that this much needed additional space is on track for completion by the time school reopens for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Graduation as it was originally scheduled on June 17th will not be able to happen in person, but we want our entire school community to know that we are actively developing a range of ways to remotely celebrate our graduates. We are closely monitoring public health information and advisories and as soon as there is clarity about when it will be safe, we will schedule an in-person graduation ceremony. We are committed to ensuring that each of our graduates receives the individualized support they need to feel ready for their post-high school plans,

- The last official day of school for the current 2019-2020 school year will now be Tuesday, June 16th. This change is as a result of remaining operational during what had been scheduled to be April break.
- Please know that we are exploring all options for potential summer programming, but all
  planning is contingent on updated public health information and guidance from the Governor
  and the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. We will provide additional
  information as it becomes available. It is important to emphasize that the self-paced,
  asynchronous nature of Map Academy's academic courses means that students do not lose
  their progress in courses during the summer. At the very minimum, remote learning will be able
  to continue through the summer months.
- Enclosed with this letter you will find a calendar for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. You will notice a couple of changes.
  - Wednesday will no longer be an early release every week. Instead, one full Wednesday a month will be a staff PD day.
  - o Daily dismissal time will change to 3:00 instead of 3:30.

As you know, Map Academy is intentionally designed to do high school differently and to keep students at the center of all decisions. We will continue to apply this foundational mindset to all of our planning as we work to ensure all of our students have the support they need to continue making meaningful progress toward their goals. We are committed to continuing to evolve our strategy and approach in response to student needs. Please do not hesitate to reach out if there is anything you need or anything we can do to support you.

# <u>Unemployment</u>

Due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) impact, many individuals are struggling with loss or release of employment through temporary lay-offs, reduced work hours, or business closings due to a Stay in Place throughout Massachusetts. Even if you work part-time or full-time at a new place of employment or work multiple jobs with long time employers, you may be eligible for unemployment benefits. To check your unemployment eligibility please complete a free claim 'application' for unemployment benefits completely online. To assist with your claim, the Department of Unemployment (DUA) has waived the 1 week waiting period to authorize the payment of benefits in a timely manner.

- Go to the mass.gov website (computer is recommended)
- Select Apply for unemployment benefits
- Review what you need in order to apply online

Start the application by selecting Apply for unemployment benefits online After completing your application, please remember to check your DUA account inbox daily to see if you are approved and what steps you have to complete immediately and weekly to continue to receive the benefits.
